### **TOWN OF UNION BOARD MEETING**

#### March 6, 2024

The Regular Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Union was held on Wednesday, February 28, 2024 at 7:00 P.M. in the Town Board Room, 3111 East Main Street, Endwell, New York.

<u>BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT</u>: Supervisor Robert Mack, Councilman Thomas R. Augostini, Councilman Joseph P. Nirchi, Sr. Absent Councilman Frank Bertoni.

<u>TOWN OFFICIALS PRESENT</u>: Town Attorney Alan Pope, Deputy Town Attorney Rose Pope, Deputy Town Attorney Ryan R. Matt, Town Clerk Leonard J. Perfetti.

Supervisor Robert Mack opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Town Attorney went over the SQER review part 1 and part 2 for the Titan Project.

<u>PUBLIC HEARINGS</u>: A public hearing was called for on March 6, 2024 to consider an amendment to the Solar Local Law to give authority to the Town Board, and not the Planning Board to determine Special Permits as it pertains to Solar applications.

Gay Canough of 533 Woodford Street in Endicott asked why and could explain what the intent was. Town Attorney Alan Pope said we had a previous Public Hearing about making it fair for the residents to add a fee because these projects are complicated and second to have the Host Community or Pilot Agreement upfront in the project so we can work out the fee the developer is going to pay to the town and again a benefit to the town residents. This Public Hearing is about do we move all or some of the special permit conditions to the Town Board. The thinking on is some of the special permit conditions could be more efficient to divide up the responsibilities between the parties. No reflection on the Planning Board, they do a great job. The board is not looking at taking the technical part away from the Planning Board.

Terrance Nolan from Loadstar Energy 6 Stonehenge Road in Warrick NY asked if this process goes forward would include review by the Planning Board, site plan review and then go to the Town Board for the Special Use Permit. Town Attorney Pope said the Board has not gotten that far yet. In his thinking the site plan review would stay with the Planning Board since they have that expertise but there are other parts of the special use permit that I think better suited for the Town Board. Mr. Nolan shared what some other towns do from his past experience,



Bob Utter Airport Road asked if this was a way to go around the Planning board and do what you do. Supervisor Mack said no. Mr. Utter said is this spot zoning? Town Attorney said no because this is a PUD and needs two uses. They attorney Pope spoke about the type of Pilot this was.

As no one else wished to speak Supervisor Mack closed the Public hearing.

Supervisor Mack referred to Town Attorney Pope to go over the SEQR review for this project, parts one and two.
