



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TOWN OF UNION

The Town of Union, in cooperation with the incorporated villages of Endicott and Johnson City, receives federal funding through the Department of Housing and Urban Development under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. In August of 2024 the town is required to submit a new five-year Consolidated Plan that identifies needs in the community and outlines how the town will address those needs with the use of CDBG and other funding sources. The new plan will address Federal Fiscal Years 2025-2029 covering the period October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2030.

The town is requesting assistance in identifying emerging trends or changes in needs since the last Consolidated Plan was prepared in 2019. The Planning Department will mail the Public Survey to residents and hold a Public Hearing for additional public input. On Wednesday, December 20, 2023 the Town Board will conduct a public hearing to solicit input from interested organizations, agencies, and residents to assist in the development of priorities for the new Consolidated Plan.
