The Broome County LWRP expands upon the 2011 Intermunicipal Waterfront Public Access Plan and affords a unique opportunity for residents and visitors to help determine how the County can fully become a vibrant riverfront community with enhanced connectivity between water-dependent uses and recreational opportunities. This process will yield a unified waterfront vision that integrates a beautiful landscape and a re-imagined economy with opportunities for improved riverfront access and uses, while also preserving ecological benefits. Additionally, a **Blueway Trail Plan** will be developed as part of the LWRP that will provide guidance for safe and accessible water recreation in Broome County.
