When you guys come up with a decision that we want X amount of dollars to go to this person, Joe will then go to our Comptroller. Our Comptroller will cut the check, and it's gone. Then the reporting has to be done by both sides, however that's got to be done.

Then at current time, and we've talked about this, if all of you come up with some other programs or a need of greater than a million dollars, you come back to us and say, "Hey, we could use more money," and then the Board can vote to give you more. I believe there will be more available, but we have certain members who want to use it all on sewers and I just have a problem with that.

MR. MOODY: Just to let you know, along those lines I am working on a few projects that may need additional assistance. At some point I may be bringing that forward to the LDC Board, then with their approval, moving on to the Town Board. So, we're looking for other projects and other opportunities if you will to help as many businesses that we can with this money, and not limit us to just one or two businesses. I mean, a million dollars is not a lot, but I'm glad the Town is at least open to the opportunity to assist us with additional funding. So, I think something like that will go a long way.
