

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
TOWN OF UNION**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that the Town Board of the Town of Union, Broome County, New York has approved a resolution calling for a public hearing to solicit public input concerning an amendment of Town of Union Code Article VIII Speed Regulations Section 191-11. A, whereby the maximum speed limit on the above referenced highways would be changed as follows:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Speed Limit</b>	<b>Location</b>
Farm to Market Road	20	<u>Maine-Endwell High School</u> From 150 linear feet north of the intersection of Farm to Market Road and Hooper Road a distance of 1,320 linear feet to the north (ending 150 linear feet south of the intersection of Pleasant Drive and Farm to Market Road). 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. when school is in session.  <u>Maine-Endwell Middle School</u> From 250 linear feet south of the intersection of Farm to Market Road and Struble Road a distance of 1,000 linear feet to the north (ending 100 linear feet north of the intersection of Hillside Terrace and Farm to Market Road). 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. when school is in session.

A public hearing will be held at the Town Hall, 3111 East Main Street, Endwell, New York on Wednesday, May 18, 2022 at 7:00 P.M., at which time all persons interested in the subject matter thereof will be heard. The purpose of the public hearing shall be to receive public input and to evaluate and consider adoption of the foregoing.

Please take further notice that the proposed change in local law which is the subject matter of the public hearing is available for inspection at the Town Hall in the Town Clerk's office Monday through Friday 8:00 A.M. through 4:00 P.M.
