The Town of Union Planning Board will conduct a public hearing relative to an application by the Town of Union for a Special Use Permit to expand a public utility at 1101 River Drive (Tax Map #140.20-4-20). The property is zoned Suburban Multi-Family, and public utility uses require a Special Use Permit. The project is to replace the sanitary sewer pumping station with an upgraded system, raising station, controls and generator platform above historic flood levels, and utilizing submersible pumps in a wet well.

The public hearing will take place on Tuesday, October 19, 2021, beginning at 7:00 PM in the Town Board Meeting Room on the second floor of the Town of Union Office Building located at 3111 East Main Street, Endwell, New York.
