Nelson to sign and deliver the Additional Service Authorization Form and Supervisor Rose A. Sotak to execute all documentation necessary to undertake the change order, including any such documentation required by the Governor's Office of Storm Recovery. The Change Order is required in order to prepare up to 15 temporary easement maps and legal descriptions at a cost of \$260.00 per parcel. These costs were not included in the original bid. The easements are required in order to undertake the creek bank repair/stabilization measures along Brixius Creek. Funding for this project is available in the NY Rising budget on a reimbursement basis.
