Resolution to award the contract for the design/engineering services for the CDBG funded 800 Block-Broad St., Endicott Project in an amount not to exceed \$10,600.00 to the low bidder Griffiths Engineering, Binghamton.

Funding for this project is available in the NY Rising Patterson Creek Bank Repair/Stabilization capital improvements budget line. **Construction contracts may not be executed until GOSR has granted final approval.**
