<u>Resolution</u> to approve the 2021 Final Town of Union Budget and the 2021 Annual Fire Contracts for the Fire Protection Districts.

Resolution to award the Bid for Hooper Road/Watson Boulevard Intersection Improvements PIN# 9754.55 to Binghamton Road Electric, LLC, 170 East Service Road, Binghamton, New York, for their low bid price of \$ 397,768.50.

<u>Resolution</u> authorizing the Reconstruction/Resurfacing of Roads in and for the Town of Union, Broome County, New York, at a maximum estimated cost of \$325,000.00 and authorizing, subject to Permissive Referendum, the issuance of \$325,000.00 Bonds of said Town to pay the cost thereof.

Resolution to call for a Public Hearing to be held on Wednesday, December 2, 2020 at 7:00 P.M., in relation to the proposed Part Town sewer improvement, consisting of the West Corners Sanitary Sewer Pump Station Upgrade, at a maximum estimated cost of \$175,000. The plan of financing consists of the issuance of \$75,000 bonds and the reallocation of \$100,000 bonds issued in 2020 for Town Improvements toward this project.

Resolution authorizing purchase of a Dump Truck for the Highway Department in and for the Town of Union, Broome County, New York, at a maximum estimated cost of \$250,000.00 and authorizing, subject to permissive referendum, the issuance of \$250,000.00 Bonds of said Town to pay the cost thereof.

<u>Resolution</u> to approve and authorize Supervisor Richard A. Materese to sign the 2021 Tax Levy Option Form due by December 1, 2020 re-levying \$36,972.66 to the 2021-tax bills,

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paying by January 4, 2021 elections costs of \$148,221.00 and \$6,348.28 in water/sewer/maintenance deficits.
