Resolution to call for a Public Hearing to be held on Wednesday November 2, 2022 at 7:00 P.M. to consider the 2023 Preliminary Budget including the Annual Water Fund. Annual Sewer Fund, Annual Fire Contracts for the Fire Protection Districts, and proposed Tax Cap Override law. The Following are the proposed 2023 annual salaries for certain elected officials of the Town of Union: Supervisor - \$20,000.00; each Councilperson (4 total) - \$10,000.00; Town Clerk - \$54,040.00; each Town Justice (2 total) - \$29,840.00.

Resolution to award the bid for Carousel Horse & Chariot Restoration to WRF Designs LLC, Plainville, Connecticut, in the amount of \$342,800.00 plus \$10,985.26 for transportation. WRF Designs will pick up and return all 68 figures at one time. Figures will be returned before the start of the 2023 season. WRF Designs met all of our bid requirements. The second bidder, Susan Germain, whose bid was lower in price, was unable to meet our time constraints, felt one of the required steps of the restoration project was unnecessary and, therefore, did not include it in her bid price.
