SALUTE TO THE FLAG:

PUBLIC HEARINGS:

A Public Hearing was called for on Wednesday, January 18, 2023 at 7 PM to consider a Substantial Amendment to the Town's CDBG-CV and CV3 (CARES Act) Program and consider other budget changes to the Town's 2022 regular CDBG Budget:

- 1) Shift funds from certain unobligated COVID-19 relief activities to facilitate the installation of two Generators and three HVAC Systems located at Nichols Notch, 401 Hayes Ave, Endicott, NY (\$165,000.00); Harry L Apartments, 235 Harry L Dr., Johnson City, NY (\$160,000.00); and Wells Apartments, 299 Floral Ave, Johnson City, NY 13790 (\$65,000.00). Total allocation: \$390,000.00
- 2) Shift funds from certain unobligated COVID-19 relief activities to CHOW & Meals on Wheels of Western Broome. Each organization will receive \$75,000.00. Total allocation \$150,000.00

Amendment Details

1)

<u>CDBG-CV & CV3:</u> The Town will use CDBG-CV & CV3 funds to provide upgrades to three elderly, low-moderate income facilities within the Town of Union, Villages of Endicott and Johnson City, NY. The estimated cost for each upgrade is \$390,000.00 (\$165,000.00 Nichols Notch; \$160,000.00 Harry L Apartments; \$65,000.00 Wells Apartments).

The Town of Union will use approximately \$390,000.00 of unobligated CDBG-CV3 funding for these projects.

<u>CDBG-CV & CV3:</u> The Town will use CDBG-CV & CV3 funds to provide funding for CHOW and Meals on Wheels in the amount of \$75,000.00 each:
