

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TOWN OF UNION

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Town Board of the Town of Union, Broome County, New York has approved a resolution calling for a public hearing to solicit public input concerning a new Homestead Village Preliminary PUD Development Plan which proposes to incorporate a solar power renewable energy project into the previously approved PUD Development Plan, which new PUD includes the following mixed uses: a townhouse residential development, a hotel and conference center including a golf course, dental office use, a public utility facility, and the renewable energy facility. The public hearing shall be held pertaining to the subdivision of two parcels from 4311 Watson Boulevard for one 4.98-MegaWatt alternating current (MWac) and another 4.75-MWac renewable energy solar system. A public hearing will be held at the Town Hall, 3111 East Main Street, Endwell, New York on Wednesday, July 13, 2022 at 7:00 P.M., at which time all persons interested in the subject matter thereof will be heard. The purpose of the public hearing shall be to receive public input and to evaluate and consider adoption of the foregoing.

Please take further notice that the proposed new Homestead Village Preliminary PUD Development Plan which is the subject matter of the public hearing is available for inspection at the Town Hall in the Town Clerk's office Monday through Friday 8:00 A.M. through 4:00 P.M.
