

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
TOWN OF UNION**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Town Board of the Town of Union, Broome County, New York has approved a resolution calling for a public hearing to consider input from the residents on the Town of Union's proposed increase in water rates for certain residents who are serviced by the Choconut Water District, which said proposed rates are due to the increases the Town of Union has received from the Village of Johnson City as follows: 2013 – 50%, 2014 – 33%, and 2018 -25%. The proposed new water rates under consideration are as follows:

Effective for the December 27, 2018 quarterly water billing:

Minimum Charge \$90.00 \$10.00 increase Rate per cf 1000-7000 \$.044375 Not to exceed 25% of the rate (.0355) in effect as of December 2006

Rate per cf 7001-2000000 \$.04875 Not to exceed 50% of the rate (.0325) in effect as of December 2006

Rate per cf 2000000 & up \$.013475 Not to exceed 75% of the rate (.0077) in effect as of December 2006.

A public hearing will be held with respect to said issue at the Town Hall, 3111 East Main Street, Endwell, New York on Wednesday, December 19, 2018 at 7:00 P.M., at which time all persons interested in the subject matter thereof will be heard. The purpose of the public hearing shall be to receive public input on this issue and to evaluate and consider action related to the foregoing.

Please take further notice that the proposed rate increases which are the subject matter of the public hearing is available for inspection at the Town Hall in the Town Clerk's office Monday through Friday 8:00 A.M. through 4:00 P.M.
